Team Leader - Mongolia

The Team Leader will carry out its commitment in Ulaanbaatar (Mongolia). The project duration is 24 months and is scheduled to start roughly in June 2015. The assignment covers 650 working days.

Key qualifications and requirements:

- University degree in Law, Management, Education or a relevant directly related discipline; alternatively, an equivalent professional experience of a minimum 5 years relevant to the scope of the assignment on top of the general professional experience;
- Proven excellent report writing and communication skills in English.

General Professional Experience

- Minimum 15 years of general relevant professional experience, out of which a minimum of 5 years of direct experience in project, people and financial management;
- At least one long-term assignment of a minimum 3 years in an EU financed technical assistance programme should have been as Key Expert. This technical assistance should have been implemented in a Least Developed Country, a Low Income or a Lower Middle Income Country¹¹ as defined in the "DAC list of ODA recipients effective for reporting on 2014, 2015 and 2016 flows";
- A professional experience in any of the listed Countries (Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, Uzbekistan) and/or Mongolia of at least 2 years is an asset.

Specific professional experience

- Minimum 5 years of full-time equivalent experience in TVET related assignment in an international context (outside EU28), of which minimum 3 years in reviewing, designing curricula and occupational standards;
- Experience in sectors directly concerned by this technical assistance (vegetable, livestock or textile sector) is an asset.

Key expert – Junior TVET expert

The expert will carry out its commitment in Ulaanbaatar (Mongolia). The project duration is 24 months and is scheduled to start roughly in June 2015. The assignment covers 600 working days.

Key qualifications and requirements:

- University degree in Sociology, Education or a discipline relevant to the scope of the assignment. alternatively, an equivalent professional experience of a minimum 5 years relevant to the scope of the assignment on top of the professional experience.
- Proven excellent report writing and communication skills in English.

General Professional Experience

- Minimum 5 years of general professional experience, including a minimum of 2 years of experience in direct experience in project, people and financial management;
- Minimum 2 years of experience in an international assignment in a Least Developed Country, a Low Income or a Lower Middle Income Country³ as defined in the "DAC list of ODA recipients effective for reporting on 2014, 2015 and 2016 flows" (see link in the footnote below), is required;
- A professional experience in any of the listed countries (Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, Uzbekistan) and/or in Mongolia of more than 2 years is an asset.

Specific professional experience

- Minimum of 3 years of experience in working successfully on assessing training needs, designing training material and delivering training, as a core activity;
- Minimum 3 Institutional Capacity Assessments have been conducted.

Preferred requirements:

- Experience in designing multimedia or e-learning course materials is an asset.
- Experience in TVET programmes is an asset.
