# Coeliac Disease Management Monitoring and Diagnosis using Biosensors and an Integrated Chip System

CD-MEDICS is developing a portable analyser to test simultaneously a range of gluten antibodies and HLA types. The device can communicate with the electronic patient record, and the generic platform may be extended to cover virtually any autoantibody or HLA test as well as other applications.
